Any IT related hardware equipment, peripherals or software. Bytes main focus for the catalogue is for the supply of hardware products, peripherals and accessories. Products listed on the catalogue must be made available at the advertised price to any public sector buyer. Custom products aimed at a single buyer are not permitted.

Call off Process

Buyers access the catalogue online at <u>https://purchasingplatform.crowncommercial.gov.uk</u>

They search for and select the products they wish to purchase. The reseller with the cheapest price for that product is automatically selected to supply the goods. Buyers cannot search for resellers and are only made aware of the resellers for their goods at the time of check out. The resellers are selected on a product by product basis, so a buyers requirement may be split between several different resellers. When the buyer checks out, they have the option of completing the purchase where the catalogue sends a purchase order to the reseller, or sending an automatic notification to the resellers to provide an official quote.
