Should you utilise Copilot Chat or upgrade to the full paid license experience?

Both Copilot Chat and the premium Microsoft 365 Copilot add-on offer secure, enterprise-ready Al support - with differences in depth and integration.

Copilot Chat is a powerful, user-friendly part of the Microsoft Copilot Suite with an expanding feature set. For deeper organisational integration, Microsoft 365 Copilot - available with a paid licence - delivers advanced capabilities, richer insights, and streamlined workflows.
